

STAY OFF STAY SAFE TRACKS ARE FOR TRAINS

Railway tracks are NOT walkways. Walking or crossing anywhere other than official railway level crossings is dangerous and illegal.

What is the rail corridor?

- Railway tracks and the land around them (usually 5 metres on each side)
- · Railway bridges, tunnels, yards and depots

Why you must stay clear:

- It's a high-risk operational zone
- Trains are fast, heavy, quiet and cannot stop in a hurry
- They can come at any time from either direction, day or night
- Trains and rail vehicles always have the right of way
- Trespassing is illegal (Railways Act 2005)
- You risk being prosecuted and fined up to \$10,000

Always cross safely:

Only use official railway level crossings.

Stop. Look both ways.

Only cross when no trains or rail vehicles are in sight.
